Title: Pastor of Worship and Student Ministries

Employment Type: Full-Time (40-50 hours per week), Salaried

Job Description Summary

The Pastor of Worship and Student Ministries works in harmony with the Lead Pastor and those on the Leadership Team, having a firm grasp on the mission, values, and strategy of Fellowship Baptist Church.

This position is primarily responsible for two main components of ministry: leading our church family in corporate worship and facilitating the spiritual growth of our students. As an integral part of our vision for leadership and ministry longevity, this position requires the discipleship and development of church members as lay leaders.

Education, Experience, and Knowledge Requirements

- *A minimum Bachelor's degree, preferably in a related field (or willing to pursue one)*
- *Prior involvement in Worship and Student Ministries (paid or volunteer)*
- *Experience in leading congregational worship - (willing to develop a blended-style worship culture)*
- *Experience in preparing and presenting expository sermons*

Necessary Skills and Abilities

- *A strong composition of many or all of the following: compassion, creativity, shepherding, teaching, leadership, administration, team-building, and enthusiasm*
- *Proficient musical ability (vocal and/or instrumental)*
- *Able to articulate ideas clearly with well-developed interpersonal skills*
- *Able to pass a background check*
- *Prepared to lead others to lead*

Spiritual Development

- *Demonstrate a stable, mature Christian walk, reflecting the requirements of a Pastor (1 Timothy 3:1-13; 2 Timothy 2; Titus 1:5-9)*
- *Exhibit the fruit of the Spirit (Galatians 5:22-23)*
- *Live out a commitment to prayer and the study of God's Word*
- *A member of Fellowship in good standing or willing to become a member*
- *Committed to spiritual growth personally, as a family shepherd and as a disciple maker*

Specific Responsibilities and Duties

Pastor of Worship

- *Serve alongside the Lead Pastor to plan regular and special worship services - including weekends, weddings, funerals, and special projects*
- *Oversee the congregational singing at all regularly scheduled worship services*
- *Recruit, shepherd, train, manage, and care for volunteers that serve in the worship ministry.*
- *Supervise the worship tech ministry for all services*
- *Direct the planning, organizing, conducting, rehearsing, and evaluating of a comprehensive music program in preparing groups, soloists and choirs*
- *Work with other ministry leaders on special music needs in the total church program*
- *Coordinate the music program with the organizational calendar and emphases of the church*
- *Maintain a familiarity with different styles of sacred music ranging from traditional to contemporary; remaining informed on music methods, materials, promotion and administration*
- *Prepare an annual music budget for approval and administer the budget*
- *Oversee the purchasing, maintenance, and replacement of all music-related equipment, supplies and instruments*

Pastor of Student Ministries

- *Serve alongside the Lead Pastor to facilitate the church's efforts to minister to youth from infancy through 12th grade*

- *Recruit, shepherd, train, manage, and care for volunteers that serve in the youth ministry.*
- *Develop and execute a well-rounded, strategic, and long-term vision for the youth ministry - including a teaching calendar, discipleship plan, outreach to unchurched youth in our community, and youth's involvement in serving the rest of the church*
- *Lead weekly teen services that inspire sincerity, unity, and Christ-likeness through fun games, meaningful fellowship, and clear bible teaching*
- *Oversee all summer youth camp activities*
- *Prepare an annual youth budget for approval and administer the budget*
- *Oversee the purchasing, maintenance, and replacement of all youth-related equipment and supplies*

General Pastoral Responsibilities

- *Remain flexible to serve the needs of our church family*
- *Preach/Teach in adult services once a month and/or when needed*
- *Participate in regular home, hospital, and prospect visitation*
- *Participate in staff meetings, Leadership Team meetings, and retreats*
